Everything starts on Friday evening with a \$24 pass that includes the option of sleeping over and a pancake breakfast Saturday morning, and all-night access to the IMAX. Thanks to the support of SaskCentral, admission prices drop to just \$12 for Adults, but include hourly hands-on workshops, make and take activities, special workshops, unique activities for families, and even a football skills course!
