

Kramer IMAX Theatre Brings Grasslands National Park To The Big Screen

(October 7th, 2022) – **Regina, SK** – During the weekend of October 21st visitors to the Kramer IMAX Theatre at the Saskatchewan Science Centre will be able to explore the Grasslands National Park on the giant screen.

Wild Prairie Man is a Cannes World Film Festival award winning documentary created by Saskatchewan based filmmaker George Tsougrianis.

Though not in IMAX format, *Wild Prairie Man* is an intimate look at the life of a man enthralled with the exotic and endangered lands of Grasslands National Park. Located in the Northern Great Plains of Canada, Grasslands has been a 20-year odyssey for wildlife photographer James R. Page. For James, critters are more interesting than people and, in this documentary, he shares some of his iconic images and experiences from this endangered ecosystem.

"The Kramer IMAX Theatre is the premiere movie screen in the province. As an independent, non-profit educational institution we are known for bringing giant screen documentary and IMAX Feature-Length films to the people of the Saskatchewan," explained Ryan Holota, COO of the Saskatchewan Science Centre. "We also have a long history of showcasing Saskatchewan filmmakers. *Wild Prairie Man* allows us to share a beautiful film that also happens to highlight two Saskatchewan treasures – Grasslands National Park and the photographer that has dedicated his life to this endangered ecosystem."

Three screenings are planned for the weekend, with a special event on the evening of October 21st where Tsougrianis will introduce the film, followed by a meet and greet where people can discuss what they have seen.
